

Skin Checks

A highly valued and essential part of any Health and Wellbeing program.
Essential for early detection, to reduce the potential impact on employees and your company.

Our skin checks are expertly performed by a Dermatoscopist Skin Specialist Nurse using a dermatoscope. The dermatoscope allows for a clear and deep view into pigmented lesions enabling skin irregularities to be identified and ultimately to the early detection of melanoma.

Our skin specialist will make prevention recommendations and refer any abnormalities to the employee's own GP for further consultation. Our Skin Specialist Nurses often identify and will refer for Basal Cell Carcinoma, Squamous Cell Carcinoma and Melanoma.

All screenings include skin care education and access to an online resource portal with educational resources - videos, information flyers etc.

We offer two skin checks:
Standard Check – 15 minutes
Premium Check – 20 minutes

Services include:

- Skin mapping – skin lesions/mole images are saved and available for year-on-year comparison
- Referrals to GP for follow up
- Detailed reporting
- Instant employee results – online downloadable results booklet
- Skin education
- Access to online resource portal
 - Information flyers
 - Sun & skin educational videos

Our statistics

- In 2018/9 Health at Work completed over 8,000 skin checks across 46 companies.
- We found (on average) two employees with melanomas in 40% of those companies
 - 29% were referred to their GP for follow up on suspicious moles, lesions, cancers, of these
 - 29% were referred for melanoma
- Blue Collar workers had 15% more referrals for melanoma than White Collar.



Did you know?

Approximately, two in three Australians will be diagnosed with skin cancer by the time they are 70, with more than 750,000 people treated for one or more non-melanoma skin cancers in Australia each year.



Reporting

Employees will be able to access their results via our secure My Health Portal and can download their results at anytime.

You will receive your own secure reporting log in to access the live data for completed screening at your convenience.

From this secure log in, you can access:

- Demographic data
- Number of screenings completed
- Referral of type and body area

At the completion of your program, you will receive a de-identified company report that includes:

- Bookings offered / apt. made / apt conducted, per site
- Referrals by type & area of the body
- Employee risk factors

Secure data

All results from the skin checks are stored in a secure medical data base – My Health Portal.

How it all works



Your dedicated Program Manager (PM) will meet with you to understand your program goals, key milestones and communication preferences. A personalised program plan will be developed.



Receive all marketing materials and personalised program plan.



Launch your program. We recommend a two week promotion period and a four week assessment period.



Receive your log in to monitor your live program progress. Your PM will re-assess engagement and re-evaluate any further promotions required with you.



The resource portal is accessible for four weeks post assessment for continued employee support.



Your PM will meet with you to debrief your assessment results and give recommendations for future targeted strategies.
